## Bridge and the Comics

"If life were a bridge game, you'd be a permanent dummy."  
— Mr. Dithers to Dagwood in the comic strip "Blondie"

Over the years, the game of bridge has turned up frequently in a few comic strips, most notably "Blondie" and "Peanuts." In one Sunday Blondie strip, Dagwood is being corralled as a fourth by his wife and two of her friends. Herb Woodley helps the women chase Dagwood all over the neighborhood, over fences, up on a roof, etc. In the next to last panel, Dagwood has hidden in a closet, shouting out, "I've locked myself in and swallowed the key." In the last panel, Herb Woodley is the conscripted fourth, sitting at the table with a pained look on his face and remarking, "That sure took a nasty turn." In Peanuts, the bridge players were not Charlie Brown or Lucy

or Linus or any of the kids, but Woodstock and his fellow feathered friends, with Snoopy occasionally drafted as a fourth. Sunday strips included actual hand diagrams. In one strip, Snoopy gets his nose stuck in a birdhouse attempting to kibitz a bridge game. In another strip, Woodstock and three friends are seen carrying a table, chairs and cards into Snoopy's doghouse on top of a small hill. Snoopy, on the roof, looks down and thinks to himself, "Normally, I don't approve of cards, but bridge is a pretty good game and after all, they do need a place to play."

In the next several panels, you can't actually see the birds, but the auction can be seen emerging from Snoopy's doghouse. A particular bid is sharply questioned, followed by the characteristic mixture of question marks, asterisks and exclamation points. In the next to last panel, the birds come tumbling out of the doghouse in a frenzied whirl of chairs, cards and feathers. In the final panel Snoopy thinks to himself:

"Some people just shouldn't play bridge together."

Indeed, comic strips can parallel real life.
