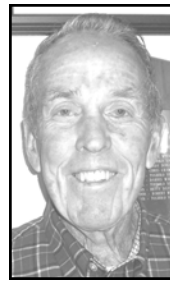

offender doesn't realize that he is offending. It is virtually inconceivable that anyone would deliberately cause discomfort to someone else - a simple pointing out of the problem should be all that is necessary. In fact, although the atmosphere at our club has, in my experience, always been warm and welcoming, our executive was anxious that I institute the procedure. I believe that since I did this (about six months ago) there has been a noticeable improvement.

--Some behaviors that may cause discomfort: (We all know these already.)

Unasked-for "bridge lessons"

Sarcastic remarks

Comments about people's play in their presence

Any type of rude or unfriendly remark

Gloating

Criticism of partner or opponent

Continued post mortems

--Other possible ramifications:

We have all heard or read about some professional players who behave in a rude or arrogant manner (likely very few). A suspension for a week might cost them some income - probably a quick cure.

What about the partner of the offender? He/she could be dealt with in the normal way that any player whose partner has to leave, for whatever reason, is dealt with.

Repeat offenders should be handled in a judicious way by the director or manager. One would suppose that anyone who is "stop-carded" more than once would "get the message" by himself.

Vindictive or vengeful "stop-carders" should also not be tolerated. The STOP card should be thought of as a "Please Stop" card. I foresee it as being used gently as a reminder.

To offer a sincere apology requires a level of poise and maturity. Some offenders might not actually be capable of apologizing. As long as the offensive behavior is stopped, that might satisfy the offended person.

--Finally: If this policy is announced clearly to all members, and as long as there is a definite plan to carry out suspensions if necessary, the chances are extremely remote that any such penalties will ever need to be imposed.
